Min. Qualifications for Award:

- OAC membership is not required to be considered
- Consistent record (if public official) for supporting policies that help further the mission of the OAC
- Recipient is only eligible to receive this award once per lifetime

Criteria Used for Review: The winner should be someone who is a proven, active leader in their community for obesity issues. This individual should be someone who engages their local community in the cause of obesity either through local government, schools, business, etc. Local government officials or leaders are eligible to receive this award.
