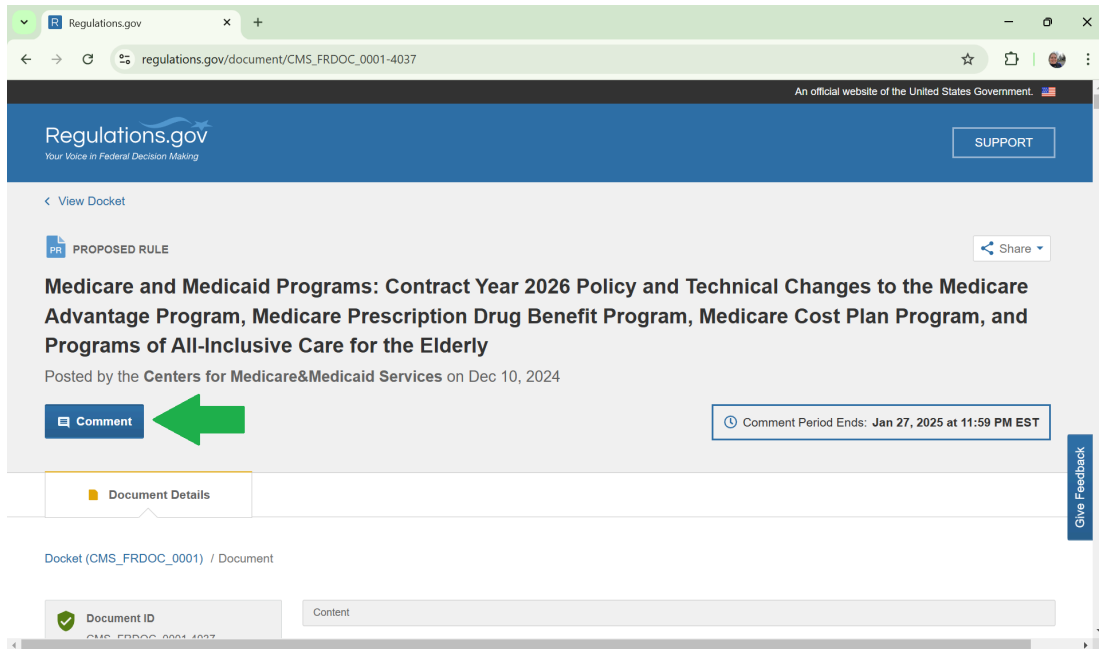


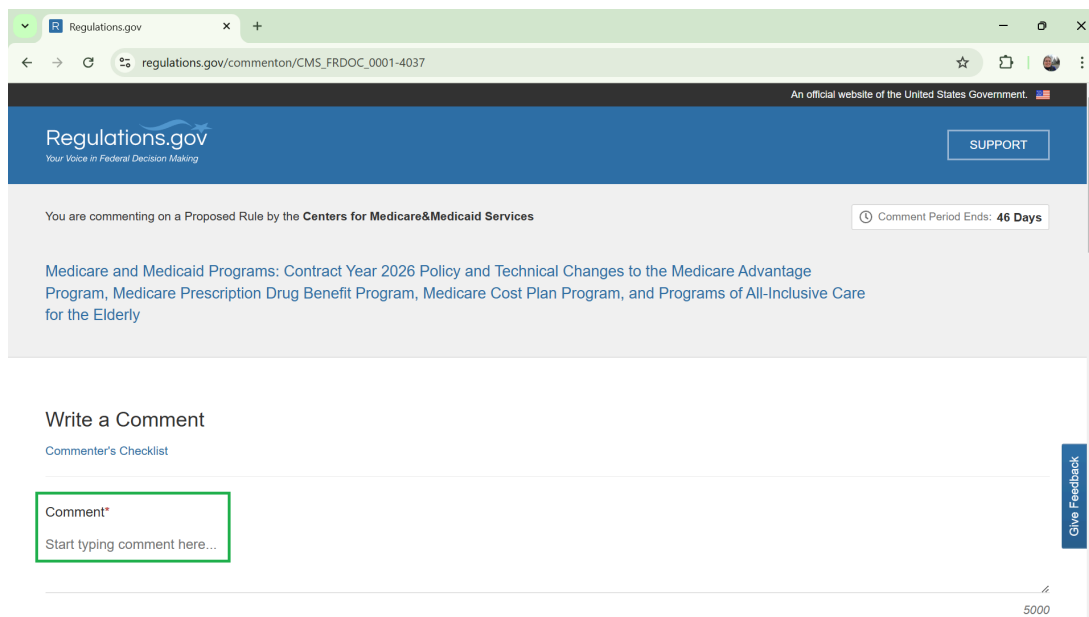


## Instructions for Submitting a Public Comment on Regulations.gov

1. Go to the [Proposed Rule on Regulations.gov](https://www.regulations.gov) then click on the “Comment” button.



2. Enter the text of your comment. **Remember to state that your comment is in reference to “Section 1.B.4. Part D Coverage of Anti-Obesity Medications (§ 423.100) and Application to the Medicaid Program”** Please note there is a 5000 character limit. If your comment is longer than 5000 characters, consider attaching it as a document.



3. "What is your comment about?" - You can leave this blank, or patients may select "Individual", if commenting for an organization or business select the best option to describe the entity.

Attach files - If you would like to attach files of a longer comment, reference articles or photos (remember the public will be able view), click on the area and follow instructions.

Enter your email address and check the box so that you'll receive a confirmation of your submission with a tracking number.
